DUBLIN CITY DEVELOPMENT PLAN 2016-2022

Notice is hereby given that Dublin City Council, in accordance with Section 12 of the Planning and Development Act 2000 (as amended), has prepared a draft City Development Plan for the period 2016-2022.

The Draft Plan is accompanied by an Environmental Report prepared in accordance with the Planning and Development (Strategic Environmental Assessment) Regulations 2004 (as amended) and an Appropriate Assessment in accordance with Article 6 of the Habitats Directive (92/43/EEC)

The Draft Plan and maps will be on public display at the locations listed hereunder from **Thursday, 1st October 2015 to Friday, 11th December 2015 inclusive:**
